Introduction

The Purpose of Homework

- To encourage pupils to develop the skills, confidence and motivation needed to study effectively on their own. This is vital, given the importance for pupils in the future, of life long learning and adaptability in the workplace;
- To extend school learning, for example through additional reading;
- To consolidate, practise and reinforce skills and understanding developed at school;
- To sustain the involvement of parents and carers in the management of pupils' learning and keeping them informed about the work pupils are doing;
- To manage particular demands, such as GCSE coursework;
- To enable work not suited to the classroom situation such as research or surveys.

We also expect all pupils to read regularly and would expect them to read for 20 – 30 minutes each evening.

General Information

A Homework Timetable will be produced at the beginning of each year to ensure that the total amount of homework set for students, either daily or weekly, is consistent and manageable for them.

All homework is set via Satchel One. All students can login to Satchel One using their academy email and password using the 'Sign in with Office 365' option. Guidance for staff on how to use Satchel One can be found [here](#).

Parents and carers can also sign in to Satchel One to see their child's homework. The Pastoral Admin Assistant monitors parent logins and contacts home where parents fail to login regularly.

Staff should ensure Satchel One is kept up to date to reflect when a student has or has not completed a task. By marking work on Satchel One as incomplete or not submitted, parents and carers will then be aware.

All students will be able to access Satchel One. Where a student needs further support to access this will be given.

Homework should be an integral element of the curriculum and feedback from the homework should be built into following lessons.

Homework needs to be given a high profile around the school and homework that is completed well should be acknowledged and praised/rewarded through positive achievements on Satchel One.

Year 9/10/11

Students should expect to receive at least one homework from each subject per week

Homework should never be set for completion the following day.

If a student does not have homework set they can do a number of personalised learning activities. There is always work to be done.

We recommend 45mins top 60– mins of work per subject per week—this can be divided into smaller tasks if desired.

We actively encourage independent study—Some suggestions are set out below.

Re-read notes from the days lessons to ensure you have understood

Read an article on a topic you have covered during the day

Make a glossary of key terms from a topic

Condense the days notes onto revision cards

Print and complete a past paper

Test spellings of key words in your subjects
