Year 12 Information Evening – Tuesday 10th March – 6.00pm

The information evening will be held in the New Hall on the Sixth Form site with parking available on the tennis courts. The evening provides a valuable opportunity for parents and students alike to learn more about the options beyond Sixth Form and offers practical advice on the university application process and other career pathways. University Visits Day – Friday 20th March

Students will attend one of **four** local universities, giving them the opportunity to experience the kind of environment they will be studying in once they leave the Sixth Form. All of these are very strong universities, offering a broad range of courses and potential career pathways. Whilst we appreciate that at this stage some students may not be sure where they would like to study, what course they would like to study or even whether Higher Education is for them, we feel that this is an invaluable experience for all students.
