Tasks:

1. Note down any key terms that you come across as you read the Story Map.
2. Complete the **Orientate** section towards the end of the Story Map – there are 6 questions to complete. Use examples where possible in your answers.
3. Complete the **Navigate** section. This requires you to summarise the article about global sense of place by Doreen Massey in 50 words (the article is also in the Story Map). There is no need to complete the globalisation essay as we will consider this later in the course.
4. Complete the **Explore** section. You need to make a 'story map' about the place in which you live. The information that you gather about your place could be in the form of maps, pictures, newspaper articles, census/ local authority data or even personal experiences. It is up to you how you present this task. Some ideas could be to present it in the form of a document, an annotated map or a collage of images. Be creative! Please note – there is no need to complete the Bristol Place Study work at the end of the Explore section.

An introduction to Disease Dilemma at A Level

You have been away from school due to Covid 19 which is an excellent example of a communicable disease. We would like you to look at how the media has portrayed the pandemic and find two contrasting articles and complete the following tasks. For the third task you could look at a range of articles to help.

1. Summarise the main information you found out about the pandemic in each article.

2. For each article evaluate it as a source of information. Explain the strengths, weaknesses and overall reliability of the source.
3. Explain why you think the articles are contrasting.
4. The main impact of Covid 19 has been economic – discuss, in this answer if they might also be social and political for example. Back up your answer with evidence

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
