

## English Literature A Level Work

Here is a choice of tasks you could do in preparation for studying the English Literature A Level:

<p>Research and create a two-page fact file on each of the following writers: William Shakespeare, John Keats, Arthur Miller</p>	<p>Create a definition sheet of 30 different language and structural techniques.</p>	<p>Write a short response to the following question: Which literary character would you want to meet and why?</p>
<p>Create a time-line of all the different movements in literature beginning with the 14th century and ending with modern literature.</p>	<p>Read at least one novel from the suggested wider reading list. Write a review of about 500 words, focusing on what you found most interesting about this novel and the way its author presented characters, issues and ideas.</p>	<p>Choose a modern/contemporary book and write a short piece arguing for the book to be recognised as part of the literary canon.</p>
<p>Write a report explaining which 3 books you would take if you were deserted on an island and why.</p>	<p>Research Aristotle's definition of tragedy and tragic features.</p>	<p>Write an analysis of a poem of your choice, using appropriate literary terminology.</p>
