

Dear Parents/Carers

As we come to the end of Module 5, I wanted to update you on a few things that are specific to Year 10.

As you will be aware, Year 10 students were due to sit their GCSE RE examination this summer. The examination will not go ahead, and Ofqual have confirmed that Year 10 students who were entered for that examination will be treated in exactly the same way as Year 11 students who were entered for examinations this year. This means that the Academy have been asked to provide evidence to the examination board for each student to help to provide them with an accurate grade. The final grades awarded will be based on a number of pieces of evidence and not limited to formal assessment such as mock examinations. We are carefully looking at how we can put this in place, while at the same time keeping the safety of our staff and students as our highest priority. We will be in touch further about this shortly.

I hope that you and your families are all well and adapting to the unusual situation we find ourselves in. I have been incredibly impressed with the way that Year 10 students have reacted to the challenges faced by online learning. I know that it has been very hard for many of them, but the resilience and independence that they have developed during this time will be invaluable throughout their lives.
