Children in Year 8 only

Your child's HPV vaccination is now due. We are writing to offer you the opportunity to have your child immunised.

The HPV vaccine protects against several types of cancer is being offered to your child at school. To get the best protection, two doses are required; the first dose to be given in year 8, the second dose to be given in year 9.

Please discuss this with your son or daughter, and then complete the online consent form before the vaccination is due.

You will need to enter the following code to ensure the completed form can be correctly allocated to your child's school: **EE135565**

We will attempt to vaccinate your child in school on 2 separate occasions. If we do not vaccinate your child in school, we will contact you to make further arrangements.

The second dose will be given approximately one year after the date of the first dose.
