As our students return to the Academy, they will no longer be in year group 'bubbles', with the exception of lunchtime. Students will move around the Academy for lessons between the different departments. However, due to the benefits experienced last year, students will start the school day with a timetabled subject lesson at 0830 with tutor time remaining in the middle of the day. However, on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> September students will begin the academy day in their form rooms. Please be assured we will be on duty directing students to their form areas.

With regards to Health and Safety requirements we continue to follow the advice from the government in order to mitigate against transmission of Covid-19 as much as possible. As you will be aware face coverings are no longer advised for students, staff and visitors either in classrooms or in communal areas. However, we are supportive of all students and staff who wish to wear face coverings while in the Academy. The on-going control measures that are advised are:

- 1. Ensure good hygiene for everyone.
- 2. Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes.
- 3. Keep occupied spaces well ventilated.
- 4. Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19.

In respect of the first three measures, we have retained all the measures we had in place on site last academic year. Although bubbles are no longer required, we have in effect retained bubbles at lunchtimes and year groups have their own designated areas. As with last academic year, please can we request that parents/carers remain in their cars when dropping off and collecting their child at the start and end of the academy day.

With the increase in online payments for educational visits and most other items we have moved the remaining academy shop facilities to our Main Reception from Student Reception. This has provided the opportunity to

develop a Pastoral Hub in the previous Student Reception area as additional space to provide additional pastoral and welfare support for our students.
