Academy says AI movies could win Oscars.

The new rules issued by the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Scientists on Monday 21st of April state that the use of Al would "neither help nor harm the chance of achieving a nomination". In March, a few of the films that achieved top industry accolades were helped by generative AI – a system that uses single text prompts to generate anything from videos to text. Luckily for movie directors, the Academy explained that human-made movies would still be considered. Since the changes to the rules, it has been decided that members of the Academy should watch and review all nominations in each category to enable them to take part in the final vote (which determines the winners). You might be wondering why this new rule was made: it all started when AI was used to perfect the actor Adrian Brody's accent while speaking Hungarian in The Brutalist. He later took home an award for Best Actor. This sparked quite a few people's interest in AI, and a similar voice effect was used in the musical Emilia Perez – where it was used to enhance singing. This musical also won an Oscar. However, the usage of AI also sparked some controversy, with many artists and actors voicing their worries concerning the training of such tools and its impact on movie writers. Co-founder and chairman of the streaming service Rokit Fix, Jonathan Kendrick, who was against the idea, explained that "it's like having a bad writer help you," and that "Sure, it'll get a outline done, but if you need something with emotional weight, AI isn't going to get you an Oscar."

Arne Slot has an incredible first season with Liverpool F.C

The end of last season was quite hard for Liverpool fans with Jurgen Klopp leaving and a multitude of players leaving as well including Thiago Alcantara and Roberto Firmino to name a couple. It was a sad last game of the season but Jurgen made it a game Liverpool fans won't forget. Then there was the case of bringing in a new manager/head coach and after much consideration, one man was chosen: Arne Slot. Many thought that this would be a tough season for Liverpool because of the new manager scenario, but looking at how the season has gone, its safe to say those who thought that were quite far from the truth.

The Dutchman was in quite the battle to be chosen as new L.F.C manager with Xabi Alonso (Ex-Liverpool player) and Roberto De Zerbi also in the conversation for it. However Slot was chosen in the end to current Liverpool fans' delight. His experience at other clubs are thought to be one reason for the signing, like winning the Eredivisie title (Dutch league) in 2022/23 and the KNVB cup (Dutch cup) in 2023/24.

All this and he only made two signings in the summer transfer window: Federico Chiesa and Giorgi Mamardashvilli, who has not yet made his debut for the club as the contract included him staying in Spain for this season. What you can't forget about however is what Liverpool have done in his time at the club already. He took them to a league cup final, and took them first place in the league stage of the Champions' League, before being knocked out by PSG in the round of 16. He has also led them to losing a minimal amount of games this season: one loss at home 1-0 to Nottingham Forest, who have had a shocking season themselves, a 3-2 loss away to Fulham, and a 3-2 loss to PSV in the Champions' League to name a few of the times they have lost this season. This is not to take away from all the wins this season, however, as it was official from Sunday 27th April 2025 that they have indeed won the league in Slot's first season! Truly extraordinary!!

The Monkey

Written and directed by Osgood Perkins, 'The Monkey' was released on 21st February 2025. The film is based on Stephen King's 1980 short story of the same name. King has also written 'The Shining,' 'Stand by me,' and 'Cujo'.

'The Monkey' stars Theo James as twin brothers Hal and Bill, whose lives are turned upside down by a cursed toy monkey that causes random terrifying deaths around them.

Made on an estimated budget of \$11million, the film passes a major box office milestone of making a total of \$60.1million worldwide.

The original story featured the monkey toy banging cymbals, but they were replaced with a drum for the film.

The Guardian review by Benjamin "tiresome, juvenile adaptation of a Stephen King short story about an evil toy monkey", "There is no sense of dread or fear despite the setup [...] the gore itself is too cartoonish to penetrate." "The deaths here are neither funny nor scary or even gross enough to linger"

Personal rating: I do agree that there was not any message to take from this film, but there was a hint of humour and horror. This Film is good for older viewers who are not into horror, but do want a taste of it. I have not seen any other of Perkins films, so maybe this was a one time flop?

Spring

Spring consists of the months of March, April, and May. Spring is the beginning of the period of time when plants and flowers start to regrow, animals waking up from their winter of hibernation and longer days.
