Key Stage 4 – Year 9/10/11

 3 bands into 2 bands P and Q.
- Continue with Core Subjects:

English, Mathematics, Science, RE and Core PE.

Choose 4 further options.




Why choose options now?

- Science either combined (2 GCSEs) or separate (3 GCSEs)
- Modern Foreign Languages
- History or Geography

HELP YOUR CHILD MAKE THE BEST GCSE CHOICES

You and your child may currently be considering, with advice from their school, what GCSE subjects they should take next year.

The Department for Education recommends these core subjects, which make up the English Baccalaureate (EBacc), and help keep options for young people open:

- English language and English literature
- Maths
- Science Combined science or 3 single sciences from Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Computer science
- History or Geography
- A language
