Covid-19

- At current there is no requirement to have a proof of vaccination entering France, Germany, Belgium and Austria
- These are to ensure that the coach can take the most ideal route to our destination

 There are currently strikes in France causing delays around Petrol and Diesel stations that may delay the journey



Applying for healthcare cover abroad (GHIC and EHIC)

- There are 2 types of cover available.
- You can apply for either:
- a UK Global Health Insurance Card (UK GHIC)
- a UK European Health Insurance Card (UK EHIC), if you have rights under the Withdrawal Agreement



Itinerary

Day	Activity
Friday	All students to bring bags and equipment to the old school hall before form time. Students will be going to Period 1 & 2 and packing the bus after break. Coach departs 12:00
Saturday	Arriving at the resort at roughly 15:00, students will unpack and pick up Ski equipment for following week
Sunday	Students are put into ski instructor groups and lessons begin
Monday	Skiing in the day and then a Hostel Quiz in the evening
Tuesday	Skiing in the day and then Ice Skating (TBC) in the evening
Wednesday	Skiing in the day and then Curling (TBC) in the evening
Thursday	Skiing in the day and then an Ice cream trip in the evening (TBC) . Students will pack bags for trip home
Friday	Skiing in the morning (weather permitting), taking back equipment then leaving on bus.
Saturday	Students should arrive back home roughly 17:00 dependant on weather and traffic to be picked up from site.
