Every year the Priory Academies support many charity groups. This year, we are asking you to join us all in raising money for an admirable local cause – St Barnabas Hospice, based in both Lincoln and Grantham.

The Priory Trust is planning to stage a unique event on **21**st **September 2019** when we run the first ever **Priory Mighty Mudder**. Our aim is to bring together more than 1,000 people from the Priory family – be they students, staff, parents or friends. It will be a great way for everyone to enjoy a challenge and an afternoon out while, at the same time, raising funds for St Barnabas.

What is Mighty Mudder?

Event: Run through muddy fields, crawl through tunnels, swing through the woods, slide down drops, wade through dirty water, fight your way up steep hills, with more than 90 obstacles to overcome

When: Saturday 21st September 2019

Where: Ancaster Leisure, Wood Lodge, Ancaster, Grantham, NG32 3PY

Why: To raise funds as a whole Trust for a Lincolnshire cause

Age: 11 and above (5km course)

5-10 (1.5km course)

Cost: £35 per person aged 11 and above (£15 entry and minimum £20 fundraising)

£10 entry per child aged 5 to 10

We need a *minimum* of 1,000 people to make the event viable for the organisers on 21st September. So please get your family and friends involved, pledge yourselves to the cause and rise to this year's charity challenge with us.
