Dear Parent/Carer

Year 9 students will be sitting internal examinations during the week beginning Monday 29th April. Examinations will be sat in English, Maths, Science, French, German, Religious Education, History and Geography. Dual linguists will not sit an examination in their new language, but will be examined on the language they have studied since Year 7. These tests are to check your child's current progress, and are not to cause any undue concern. Students will need a black ball point pen for the examinations, in addition to the usual academy equipment of a pencil, eraser, ruler and calculator. A compass and protractor will also be needed for Mathematics papers. If students would like to take water in with them, then it must be in a clear plastic bottle with no labels. The tests will be carried out under full GCSE examination conditions, which may include students being searched for banned items if they have to leave the hall in the middle of an examination.
