

Dear Parents/Carers

12<sup>th</sup> September 2018

I would like to invite your child to take part in an educational visit to Paris for students of French in Year 10 from the 22<sup>nd</sup> to the 25<sup>th</sup> June 2019. Travel throughout will be by executive coach and students will be able to participate in a visit which offers a charming taste of the French capital as well as carefully planned language activities, including a specially tailored French workshop run by staff at the campus where we will be staying. All meals/entrance fees are included in the price, and accommodation will be in Campus Sainte-Therese, with students staying in multi-bedded rooms and all rooms having private facilities. The proposed itinerary is as follows:

**Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> June:** The coach will collect us in the morning from the Academy to travel to Dover. We will arrive at the Campus Sainte-Therese in the evening.

**Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> June:** Day of sight-seeing in Paris, with a boat trip on the Seine and various opportunities to practise transactional French.

**Monday 24<sup>th</sup> June:** Morning workshop with French staff from the Campus, followed by a French-language tour of the Stade de France, the stadium where the French team won the Football World Cup in 1998. We will then travel into Central Paris to Montmartre to see the famous Sacre Coeur Basilica and the Place de Tertre (Artists' Square). After an evening meal at a restaurant next to the Pompidou Centre, we will transfer to Tour Montparnasse, where we can complete the French Language Quiz and enjoy amazing views of Paris.

**Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> June:** We will depart the hotel after breakfast and visit a chocolate factory in Lachelle. We will then continue to Calais for our ferry crossing to Dover, returning to the Academy in the evening.

It is estimated that the cost of the trip will be in the region of £395 per student based on a group of 40 students in total.

As there are a limited number of places available on the visit, if you wish your child to be considered then please complete the reply slip below. Replies should be taken to Student Reception by **17**<sup>th</sup> **September 2018**. Places will be allocated by a random computerised draw. However, those students who do not receive a place on this trip will be monitored in terms of other visits taking place during the year. Replies will not be accepted if they arrive after the deadline or through any other method. Please advise your child to hand their reply in personally and not to pass it on to one of their friends.
